- 1:1–5** Greetings
- 1:6–10** There is no gospel other than that of Christ
- 1:11–24** God called and trained Paul to be an authoritative apostle
- 2:1–10** The apostles accepted Paul at Jerusalem
- 2:11–14** Paul rebuked Peter at Antioch over the Jewish dilemma
- 2:15–21** Jews, like Gentiles, are saved by faith in Christ
- 3:1–14** The proof of justification by faith in Christ, while a curse was brought by the law
- 3:15–18** The law did not cancel the promise given to Abraham
- 3:19–22** The law was given looking toward Christ

- 4:1–11** We are God's sons and heirs, and no more servants
- 4:12–20** Therefore we should remain zealous in righteousness
- 4:21–31** Hagar and Sarah form a compelling allegory of Jews and Gentiles
- 5:1–15** Christian liberty is in faith and charity
- 5:16–26** Fruits of spirit and works of flesh
- 6:1–10** On kindness, humility, perseverance, and bearing one another's burdens
- 6:11–18** Final warning and blessing
